Eastern Rio Blanco County residents who have already graduated from high school and who are pursuing an education in the healthcare field. (Nursing--RN or LPN, Radiological Technology, Respiratory Therapy, Medical Technology, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Pharmacy, Physician, psychiatrist, psychologist), or a non-clinical healthcare field (medical transcription, coder, and billing).

Applicants must have already been accepted into a college/university or accredited school in the program of his/her choice. This award is based on the individual's motivation, goals, background, and community involvement.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000
Eligibility: **Current PMC employees**, of at least 6-months, who wish to further their healthcare career and credentialing.

Applicant must have already been accepted at a college/university in the program of his/her choice, or be a student in good standing with a 2.5 G.P.A. enrolled in an accredited college.

Eligibility: **Senior graduating from Meeker High School** pursuing collegiate study in healthcare fields. (Nursing--RN or LPN, Radiological Technology, Respiratory Therapy, Medical Technology, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Pharmacy, or Physician.)

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior and is awarded based on a student's academic performance, commitment to their education, commitment to serving others, and community involvement. A strong academic performance is important. Applicant must have a 3.0 G.P.A.

Applicants must have already been accepted into a college/university or accredited school in the program of his/her choice.

Description: This scholarship will be awarded to a Meeker resident who has completed his or her Associate's or bachelor's degree, and is now pursuing a **post-graduate level degree** in a healthcare-related field. (i.e. Physician, Masters's in Nursing in a specialized field, Anesthesiology Assistant, Physical Therapist, Speech Therapist, Occupational Therapist, Physician Assistant, Psychologist, Pharmacist, etc.)

Scholarship Amount: Up to \$4,000 as a \$1,000 annual-renewable scholarship to be paid out for up to 4 years. The recipient must maintain at least a 3.0 G.P.A, or a letter, from the school, stating you are a student in good standing throughout the graduate school to be eligible for renewal.
